

## CSSP2 Pipeline Grants Windows Update\_ (June 14, 2022)

As of April 1, 2022, the Civil Society Support Programme Two (CSSP2) has secured costed extension funding. During the costed extension period, CSSP2 will open different windows of grants to deepen and scale up its work which has been implemented with civil society organisation (CSO) partners. To this end, as indicated in the below results framework of the programme, CSSP2 plans to provide more grants to CSOs throughout the country (in all the 11 national regional states and the two city administrations).

### Results Framework of CSSP2

**Impact:** To contribute to inclusive and accountable governance; and an improved environment for the promotion and protection of the human rights of all Ethiopians

**Outcome 1 -** Increased capacity of CSOs to become active organizations and capable advocates on CSSP2 strategic themes

**Outcome 2 -** Enhanced citizen-state engagement on CSSP2 strategic themes

**Outputs:**

- 1.1. CSOs provided with technical capacity development support on the thematic issues and organizational development
- 1.2. CSOs provided grants for effective and efficient delivery of projects

**Outputs :**

- 2.1. Increased capacity of relevant government stakeholders for constructive CSE
- 2.2. Evidence and learning product collected, collated & shared
- 2.3. Effective platforms and spaces created

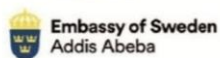
